Tree planting in 2021 – Agreements from Call on 6th December

Participants: Jimmy, Ronny, Marcus (all via WhatsApp Call)

Ongoing and continuous need for ISCOT/Jimmy to send to MttW/Marcus:

- Pictures
- distribution documentation
- receipts and other proof of spend money

Tree planting in 2021:

- further need for reforestation in Madi Opei and Kitgum district as well as more neighbouring districts, big area – big potential
- natural challenges: survival rate depends on tree
- social challenges: some people very interested, others are not good care takers
 → learnings: stick to certain kind of trees and only distribute to people that are eager to
 participate

Jimmy and Joel, as ISCOT, will participate again and organize locally in Madi Opei.

Prices will stay in the same range as last year, Joel and his team will constantly work to get them as low as possible for ISCOT and MttW to buy as many as possible with the available funds.

With an absolute number ordered by December 2020, first seedlings will be ready for distribution by end of march 2021. Participation of a MttW-Team will depend on the pandemic situation and possibility to travel.

Order of seedlings from Joels nursery bed by Magic to the World e.V.

Magic to the World e.V. agrees and confirms to buy a total of 40.000 seedlings at the price of 1.500 UGX maximum each for distribution before and during the first rainy season of 2021.

A deposit of up to 30% can be arranged in December 2021. After confirmation a second instalment of 30% can be fixed in February 2021 before the final payment, 40%, upon delivery. Every payment requires a separate bill addressed to ISCOT and Magic to the World e.V. (Germany)

We appreciate if options for an additional 10.000 seedling would be available on short notice from this or other nursery beds depending on the successful funding by MttW.
